

Drs. Deutscher, Rottinghaus & Oxandale Contact Lens Policy

Effective 01/01/19


1. When a contact lens patient has their yearly exam a contact lens evaluation (CPT code 92310) will be performed and a \$35 fee charged. This includes:
 - a. Evaluation of the patient's contact lens visual needs
 - b. Visual acuity (evaluation of how you see out of the current contacts)
 - c. Evaluation of the current fit of the contact on the eye and adjustments of power
 - d. Corneal health evaluation (where the contact sits)
 - e. Refraction over the contact lens on the eye to confirm the power needed
2. Patients must bring their contact lenses to their comprehensive eye exam in order to renew their contact lens prescription.
(If the patient doesn't have any contacts, trials will be given at the exam if they are in stock. If there are no trials in stock, new trials will be ordered and a separate appointment will be scheduled to perform the contact evaluation.)
3. A CONTACT LENS EVALUATION IS REQUIRED TO RENEW YOUR CURRENT CONTACT LENS PRESCRIPTION AND WILL BE BILLED IN ADDITION TO THE COMPREHENSIVE EYE EXAM FEE.
4. Refit fees will be charged if contact brands or types are changed. This fee will cover additional visits to complete the transition into the new lens. Prices will vary and will be quoted and approved by the patient before any changes are made.



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
